# Program

The Minimum Data Set Version 3.0 (MDS 3.0) is scheduled for implementation by CMS for certified nursing facilities across the nation on October 1, 2010. So now is the time to focus on the item-by-item coding, as well as how do you get prepared for the tremendous changes that will take effect? What should the action plan be? The new MDS 3.0 is four times the size of MDS 2.0 and there are some significant differences. Facilities will need to train their entire disciplinary team to be prepared. Take I-71 South toward Columbus. Take exit 108B/US 40 toward Broad Street. Turn left on Third Street (Trinity Episcopal Church is on your left). Turn left on State Street (Statehouse is on your right). CCAO is located 1 ½ blocks on the right side of the street. Turn right into parking lot entrance just past the CCAO building.

### From the North (alternate directions)
